



- Coding instruction #15: Choosing between ovary, fallopian tube, or primary peritoneal without designation of the site of origin (page 105)

Laterality: Additional Instructions

Diagnostic Confirmation



- Note added to Coding Instruction #8 (page 112)
 - 8. Assign code 7 when the only confirmation of malignancy was diagnostic imaging such as computerized axial tomography (CT scans), magnetic resonance imaging (MRI scans), or ultrasounds/sonography

Note: Intraductal papillary mucinous neoplasm with high grade dysplasia (8453/2) of the pancreas is reportable based on imaging alone; histologic confirmation is not required.

SEER Site-Specific Factor 1



Codes changed from 1 digit to 2 digits

Date Therapy Initiated: Additional Instruction



- Coding instruction 2 added (page 168)
 - 2. Record the date the decision was made for active surveillance even if the patient later changes their mind and opts for additional treatment. Code *Treatment Status* as 2, Active surveillance/watchful waiting.

Breast Reconstruction: New Data Item




 Breast Reconstruction, effective 01/01/2024, describes the reconstruction procedure immediately following resection of the breast (page 175)

New Training Section in SEER*Educate



- Assess understanding & accuracy in applying existing rules & new rules for 2024
